This is a wonderful opportunity to explore the music of Philippe Rogier, a Flemish composer who made a career in Spain. A certain amount of music was published before his untimely death in 1596, but many of his works were subsequently lost in the Lisbon earthquake some 150 years later. However enough has survived to show what fine composer he was. The music is not yet available in performing editions so we are privileged to have the benefit of Sally Dunkley's extensive work on the original scores. The music is a delight to sing - a real discovery. We are sure to benefit greatly from Sally's experience as a professional consort singer (Tallis Scholars and the Sixteen), writer, researcher and teacher.

Leominster Methodist Church is situated in Green Lane, just off the Leominster ring road. This will be a good, warm venue for the middle of winter! A large free car park is nearby. Bring your own lunch or patronise one of the many good cafes in the vicinity. Tea and coffee will be provided as usual. Bring your own cup/mug, if you wish.
