

OUTREACH FUNDING - GUIDELINES

BMEMF organises early music workshops for members and non-members at fees gauged to recover costs. In addition, the Council of BMEMF is willing to provide financial support to other ventures.

Ventures eligible for support must be aimed at increasing the public appreciation of, and participation in, early music, by means of recitals, concerts, workshops or classes. The preparation of music scores for such ventures may also be eligible. Innovative ventures are preferred. Ventures designed to benefit fewer than ten people are not eligible.

Ventures must be located in the geographical area traditionally associated with BMEMF. Spin-off into other areas may, however, be an additional benefit.

The nature of funding may fall under one or more of four headings:

- (1) Assisting especially innovative workshops.
- (2) Agreeing to meet financial loss, up to a stipulated limit.
- (3) Covering publicity costs, in whole or in part.
- (4) At no charge, inserting a leaflet with an issue of the BMEMF Newsletter.

Who can apply for funding?

BMEMF members, and non-members and not-for-profit organisations located in BMEMF's geographical area.

How to apply:

In the first instance, discuss the venture with the Treasurer.

Following discussion, submit a written proposal to the Treasurer.

The Treasurer will add comments if needed, and then submit the proposal to Council for decision.

This process will normally take 1-3 months.
