In this workshop we shall explore pieces that paint pictures of Tudor life. Street cries, the sounds of carriages, the ticking and striking of clocks, bird song, church bells - all manner of everyday noises and sights inspired music by composers such as Woodcock, Parsley, Gibbons and Dering. The workshop is suitable for recorders, soft wind, viols and strings. Parts can be provided in Treble, Bass and Alto clefs.

Our tutor, Mary Tyers M Mus LRSM LTCL LGSM, will be a familiar figure to those who attended the BMEMF online workshop, 'T'Arty tunes', that she led for us in January. She is much in demand as a tutor on residential courses such as NORVIS, and as a teacher at the Early Music Shop, Durham University and elsewhere. We're delighted that she is able to join us for this, our first in-person instrumental workshop since the pandemic.

Yarpole Parish Hall is a recently-renovated, purpose-built hall with its own car park. Hot drinks will be provided, but participants must bring their own mug and a packed lunch.
