

Covid safety precautions for BMEMF workshops

BMEMF will:

Follow the precautions required/advised by the UK Government or the Welsh Assembly which are current at the time of the workshop.

Ensure that hand sanitising facilities are available (eg by providing hand sanitiser gel).

Ensure that venues have space for sufficiently distanced seating and adequate ventilation.

Ensure good cleaning arrangements – e.g. of chairs and tables.

As far as possible, avoid situations where crowding might occur – e.g. collecting scores.

Encourage the wearing of facemasks where possible when people are moving around the building.

Inform participants if the venue is open to members of the public during the period of the workshop.

Participants:

Must not attend if they have symptoms of Covid, have had a positive test or have been in contact with anyone who has Covid symptoms or has tested positive.

Will receive a full refund if they cancel for reasons related to Covid.

Must provide contact details to the organiser.

Must inform the organiser if they develop symptoms up to 10 days after the event.

Bring their own mugs, if BMEMF is providing refreshment.
