## Course details

There are various ways one could and should commemorate the life of Josquin des Prez, who died 500 years ago in August 1521. This weekend centres on his musical legacy to the end of the sixteenth century, the rich and fascinating ways it was disseminated, adapted and emulated.

This predominantly practical course is for singers and players of early instruments (A=440) confident in a one voice or instrument per part situation. Your application should detail what you intend to offer by way of voice and/or instrument(s), especially if you are not already known to the tutor.

## Materials, Equipment & Supplements

Participants should bring their instrument(s), a marked music stand, and any music for unscheduled times.

## Tutor: Peter Syrus

Peter was until recently a lecturer at the Royal Northern College of Music in Manchester, with considerable experience in the performance of Renaissance music as both singer and instrumentalist. As well as being in constant demand for running workshops for the various Early Music Forums up and down the country, he has taught at several northern universities.
